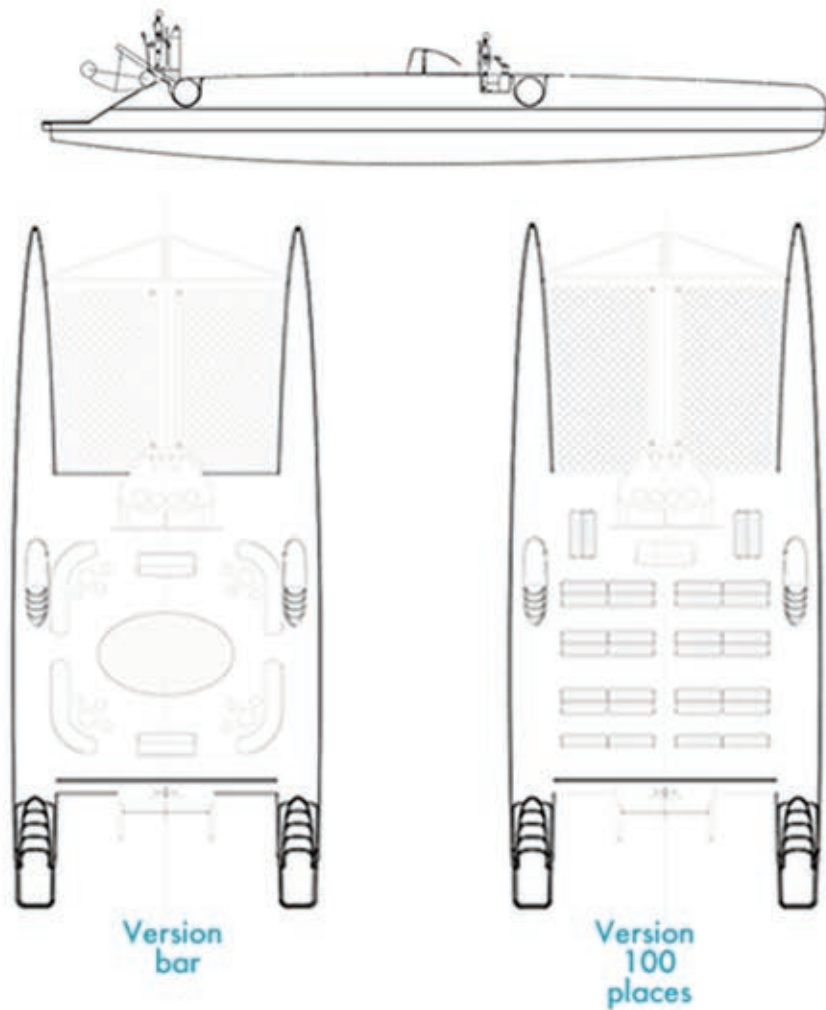


Fountaine Pajot has asserted itself as the lead international protagonist of Day Charter manufacturers since the launching of the TAÏTI line.

The TAÏTI 80 benefits from the experience of over 70 TAÏTI which have already been distributed, and represents a new generation of Day Charter which the internationally renowned shipyard, FOUNTAINE PAJOT has developed.

The TAÏTI 80 is the result of this achievement and of the collaboration with the architects JOUBERT NIVELT.





Larger capacity

This new 80' Day Charter catamaran has a passenger surface area increased by 60% compared with Taïti 75. This is due to her flat deck design.

The deck is significantly raised and sits on top of the beams.

The result : the available deck surface is 105sqm (compared with the 66sqm on the Taïti 75).

This space can be easily adjusted to accommodate seats, a bar, a dance floor etc... all at the convenience of the proprietor.

The boat has 100 very comfortable seats, i.e. 25% more than on board the Taïti 75.

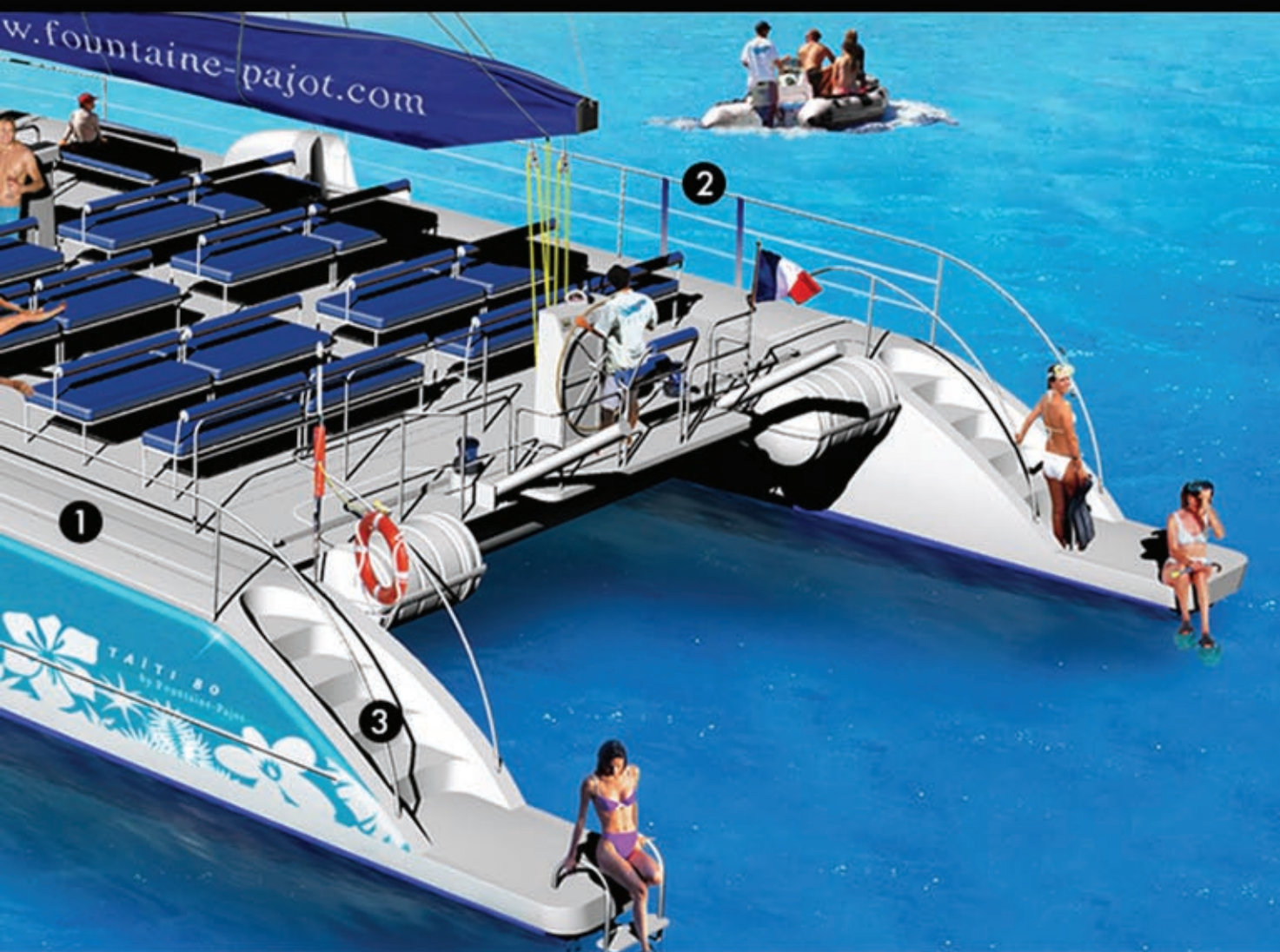




Easier manoeuvrability for a small crew

- 1 The helm is set back and raised so as to give a permanent view over all the passengers
- 2 The catwalks are clear therefore enabling people to move freely at docking
- 3 All the running rigging is grouped together at the foot of the mast, away from passengers and the main winches (GV halyards) are electrical



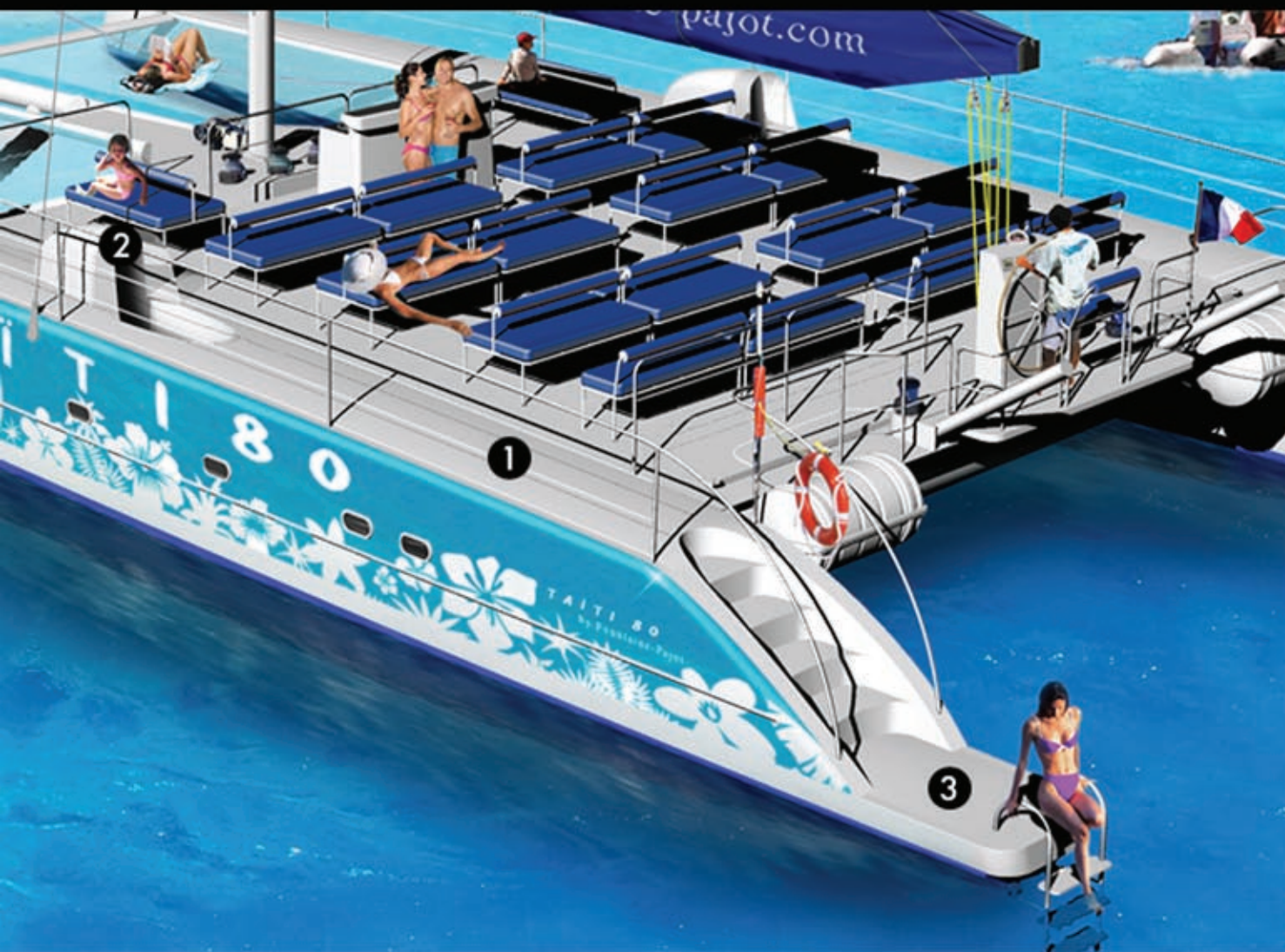


easier boarding access :

- 1 The hulls, of which the bridges are almost flat, enable passengers to board :
- 2 either sideways through open gates, thus giving easier access for passengers as well as wheelchair users on the deck.
- 3 Or from the quay at the back via a very comfortable stairwell so that passengers need not walk the beam.



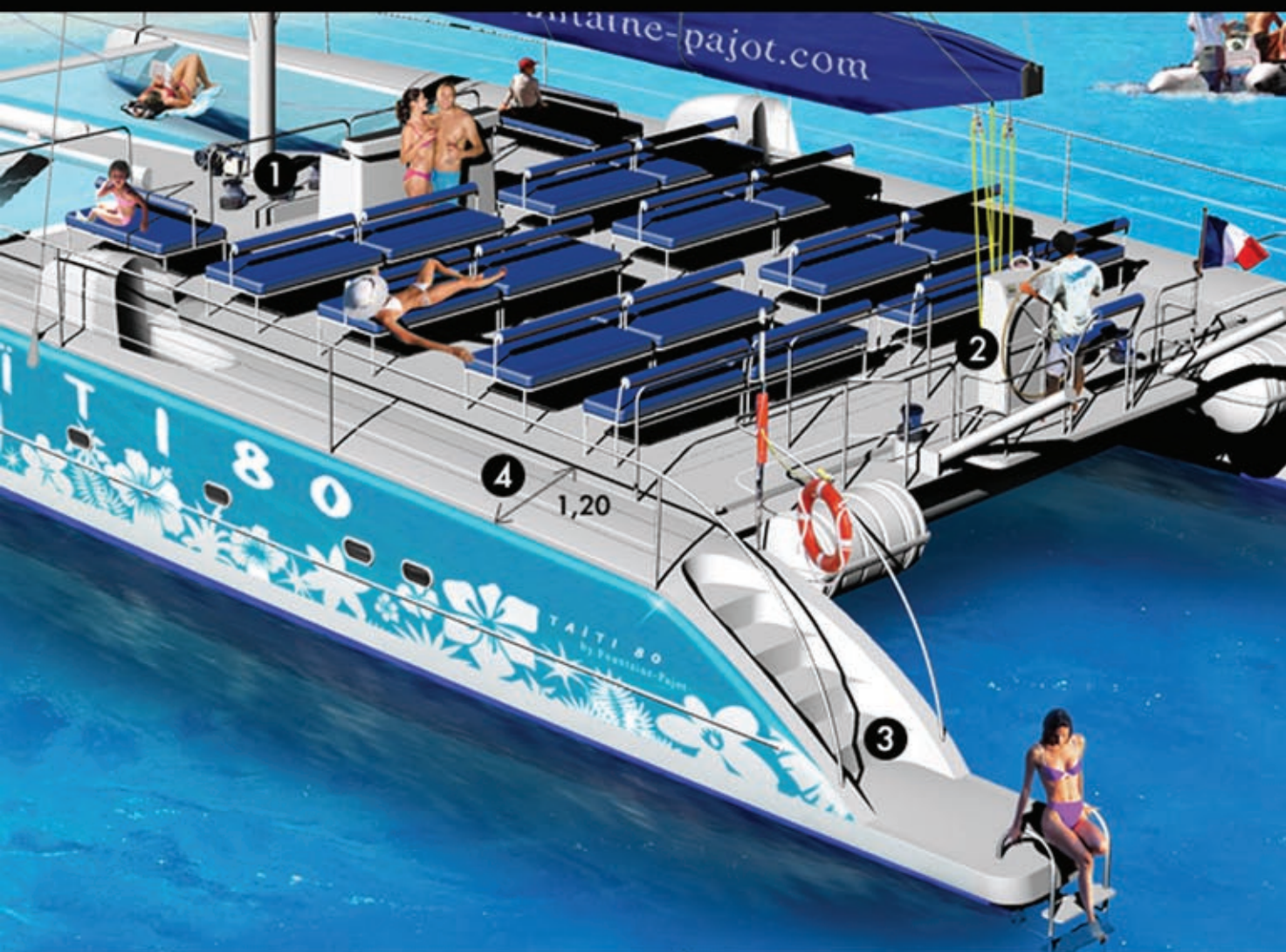

Better facilities for passengers

- 1 The open, flat deck gives more freedom of movement for passengers whilst on board.
- 2 new access to the toilet facilities with a wide staircase with banister.
- 3 the rear bathing ladders have been designed like those of a swimming pool, with a large handrail.





Better security

The rigging zones have been designed so that they are totally separate from passengers :

- 1 The position of the foot of the mast is isolated from public areas
- 2 The helm is set back and slightly raised on the rearbeam, thus saving more space.
- 3 Therefore passengers will not be disturbed during any manoeuvres.
All the staircases have even steps : to the pontoons, the way down from the hull, to avoid the risks linked to uneven steps.
- 4 Movement, generally, is increased so as to avoid congestion in certain areas.
The balconies are situated at a height of 1 metre in the passengers areas.
